Background of the Thor Diesel Club

The Mandalay Luxury Division was formed as a Division of the Four Winds International organization of the Thor Industries, Inc. In October 2003, the Mandalay Luxury Division (MLD) expressed a desire to have a "travel club" consisting of Mandalay coaches and therefore held a club-forming rally in September 2003. The first Rally was held at the Elkhart County Fairgrounds in Goshen Indiana with 48 Mandalay coaches. Coach owners present voted to name the travel club as the "Mandalay Travel Club" (MTC).

In September 2010, Four Winds International and Damon Motor Coach were merged as the Thor Motorized Services (TMS) and the Mandalay Luxury Division ceased operations. Shortly thereafter, Thor Motorized Services was renamed as Thor Motor Coach (TMC), which began producing new versions of motor coaches under the "Thor Motor Coach" name. Thor Motor Coach discontinued the Montecito introduced just at the height of the reorganization after only a short time in production. Production was also suspended on the Mandalay, Valencia, and Presidio Coaches.

The Thor motor home manufacturer once again desired a travel club that would recognize the combined coach-building strength of the Thor Motor Coach organization and in October 2010 the "Thor Diesel Club" (TDC) was formed. Initially, eligible coaches included the Astoria, Avanti, Escaper, Essence, LX400, Mandalay, Montecito, Presidio, Sahara, Serrano, Tuscany, Ultrasport and Valencia.

The Thor Diesel Club is born

October 03 – 08, 2010 (MTC's 7th International Rally) and (TDC's 1st International Rally) held in Goshen, Indiana

Attending members at the Mandalay Travel Club (MTC) 2010 International Rally overwhelmingly voted to form the Thor Diesel Club (TDC) as the official club of the newly formed Thor Motor Coach Company. The members voted that the initial set MTC dues would be divided. MTC would be \$5 per year and TDC would be \$20 per year with both clubs maintaining their current status with the Family Motor Coach Association (FMCA). It was agreed by both clubs that Thor Diesel Club would be the official club representing the Thor Motor Coach organization, and current members of the Mandalay Travel Club would be transferred (along with their dues) from the MTC treasurer to the new Thor Diesel Club as soon as the TDC set up its Bank account and was accepted by the FMCA. This newly formed Club would accept members from any Class A THOR diesel product – thereby allowing the club to offer membership to a larger and more diverse diesel product cliental. With the formation of the Thor Diesel Club a new era of support and cooperation from Thor Motor Coach began. Now owners of Four Winds International, Damon Motor Coach and Thor Motor Coach diesel products had a Club they could join that was recognized by Thor Motor coach.

Millie Cornthwaite, a friend of TDC member Fran Watkins, presented a sketch of a possible TDC logo to the club President to consider. The "T" stands for Thor. The broad massive base of the "T" represents the strong, solid grounding in the RV industry that Thor Motor Coach has to support the Club. The broad downward shaped top of the "T" represents a protective umbrella that Thor Motor Coach provides the Club as it continues to grow and prosper. The "D" and the "C" obviously stand for Diesel Club but more than that; they are slightly rounded to represent wheels, which take us on our travels wherever we want to go in luxury.

The President presented the logo to the membership and it was adopted as the Club logo. Those unable to attend the International Rally in Goshen missed seeing the beautiful cake with the Thor logo on top that Nancy Miles made, presenting it to the membership.

December 4, 2010

The Thor Diesel Club was chartered as an International Chapter of the Family Motor Coach Association. All the Members who attended the 2010 International Rally in Goshen Indiana comprised the initial membership of the Thor Diesel Club. The membership was later expanded to include everyone that was a member of the MTC as of 31 December 2010. Membership dues (those paid in advance) were transferred from MTC to TDC.

TDC's Second International Rally Them was "Let's Meet in the Middle". TDC Rally Masters were Patricia Koritta, Judi McGee and Roxie Stoner. The entertainment was awesome by the Rivoli Revue, a great and favorite musical group in the RV community. Northern Harmony Blue Grass Band also had our toes tapping and smiles on our faces. There were many vendors booths to visit, and some provided seminars. Our military was also honored at the rally. Any food that was left over from our meals was given to a local food bank. The club has grown to over 340 members of which about 25% of our members attended the rally. TDC chose to support national charities as well as charities in the local Goshen area. The TDC President and Board of Directors held a 2011 "General Membership Annual meeting" at 3:00 p.m. There were reports from the Treasurer, FMCA Business reports, and discussion of future rallies. The President presented and the membership voted and accepted changes to the Clubs By-Law changes.

Terms of office: The elected officers of this chapter shall serve a two year term of office, except for the *two* (2) at-large positions or until their successors are elected. The At-Large positions will have a (1) one, and (2) two year term remaining. The initial term of the President and Treasurer will be three (3) years in order to offset the President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer all leaving office at the same time.

- A Nominating Committee for the 2012 elections was selected. Ron Rickard, Jack Finley and Carolyn Stocker represent the Nominating Committee.
- The following coaches are eligible to become members of the Thor Diesel Club: Astoria, Avanti, Escaper, Essence, LX400, Mandalay, Montecito, Palazzo, Presidio, Sahara, Serrano, Tuscany, Ultrasport and Valencia
